## **URBAN FINANCIAL SERVICES COALITION & PACIFIC COAST BANKING SCHOOL 'RISE ABOVE THE REST™' SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

To better educate diverse and high-potential leaders in financial services, Pacific Coast Banking School joins the Urban Financial Services Coalition (UFSC) to offer a three-year tuition scholarship beginning with the 2013 Resident Session of Pacific Coast Banking School (PCBS). An outline of the proposed scholarship program follows.

### **THE PCBS PROGRAM**

Since 1938, Pacific Coast Banking School, in partnership with the University of Washington Graduate School of Business, has offered a premier three year graduate-level leadership and financial management education program focused on the banking industry. Over 10,000 bankers have graduated from this school, with hundreds currently in key leadership roles across the country. High-potential candidates in the banking and financial services community from all sizes of banks and companies benefit from outstanding instruction and cutting-edge curriculum designed to develop future leaders of the industry.

### **SCHOLARSHIP SESSION**

Students enroll in a three year program, which includes a two-week resident session each August for three years. The 2013 session dates are August 18 – 30 and is held on the University of Washington campus. Tuition is \$4,475, which includes a registration fee, single room accommodations, meals and classes, along with administrative and faculty support for intersession work. The scholarship amount will be applied to a first year student in the 2013 session and may be up to **\$3,400**, depending on the contribution from the FSC Foundation. PCBS will match the funds from the Foundation up to \$1,700. The remaining tuition balance is the responsibility of the applicant.

### **CANDIDATE PRE-REQUISITES**

The scholarship nominee must complete:

- 1 – The PCBS 2013 Session Application
- 2 – The PCBS/ UFSC Scholarship Application

These forms must be submitted by May 15, 2013.

### **THE PROCESS**

The deadline for submitting scholarship applications to the UFSC is **May 15, 2013**. Please see the application for specific instructions.
