1) LIABILITY: Upon approval of this contract by an authorized Client representative it is expressly understood that the Client has read and agrees to abide by the policies outlined below. Urban Financial Services Coalition – Puget Sound Chapter, hereinafter referred to as UFSC or Contractor and all organizations and individuals who are employed by or associated with it in connections with this Small Business Resource Centre will not assume responsibility and shall be held harmless by all Clients for damage or loss resulting from fire, theft, terrorism, or any other cause whatsoever, including accident or injury to Clients, their employees and agents, the public or others.

2) SPACE LOCATION: UFSC reserves the right to determine final placement of the ad of the Client.

3) AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES:
The Contractor shall also comply with Public Law 101-36, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, with regard to Employment, Public Services, Public Accommodations and Services, Telecommunications, et cetera as defined in the Act.

4) PROPRIETY RIGHTS: The parties to this contract hereby mutually agree that if any patentable or copyrightable material should result from work described herein, all rights accruing from such material or article shall be the sole property of the Contractor. The Contractor agrees to and does hereby grant to the Client, all federal and state agencies and the United States government, irrevocable, nonexclusive and royalty-free license to use, according to law, any material or article and use any method that may be developed as a part of the work under the contract. The foregoing license shall not apply to existing training materials, consulting aids, check lists and other materials and documents of the Contractor which are modified for use in the contract.

5) CAPACITY: The parties declare that the Contractor and any of its agents and employees, in the performance of this contract, are acting as independent contractors and not in any manner as officers, employees or agents of the Client or its governing body. The Contractor shall not in any way contract on behalf of or in the name of the Client.

6) CHANGES, MODIFICATIONS, AND AMENDMENTS /CAPTIONS:
This contract may be waived, changed, modified, or amended only by written agreement executed by both of the parties hereto. The packages are for convenience only and do not define or limit the marketing contents.

7) NONDISCRIMINATION: During the performance of this contract, the parties agree to comply with the terms of the following non-discrimination provisions as well as the Federal and state laws and regulations governing the EEOC. No person shall, on the grounds of race, creed, color, religion, gender, marital status, sexual orientation, origin, age, sensory, mental or physical handicap, or political affiliation be discriminated against or denied employment as a participant or staff person in connection with any program under this contract, provided that the prohibition against discrimination in employment because of handicap shall not apply if the particular disability prevents the proper performance of the particular work involved. In the event that one of the parties hereto refuses to comply with the above provisions, this contract may be canceled, terminated, or suspended in whole or in part by the other party.

8) CANCELLATION/SPACE REDUCTION:
Any cancellation, space reduction requests or requests for changes of this contract must be made in writing and forwarded to UFSC-PS Chapter, 3518 Fremont Avenue N #350, Seattle, WA 98103. In the event of a cancellation or a reduction of contracted space UFSC shall reserve the right to sell the cancelled space without rebate or allowance to the Client.

9) TERMINATION OF THE SMALL BUSINESS RESOURCE CENTRE VIRTUAL MARKETING CONTRACT: In the event that the premises in which the Small Business Resource Centre is or is to be conducted shall become in the sole discretion of UFSC unfit for occupancy or in the event the holding of the Small Business Resource Centre or the performance of UFSC are substantially or materially interfered with by virtue of any causes not reasonably within the control of UFSC, said Contract and/or the Small Business Resource Centre (or any part thereof) may be terminated by UFSC. UFSC shall not be responsible for delays, damage, loss, increased costs or other unfavorable conditions arising by virtue of cause or causes not reasonably within the control of UFSC. If UFSC terminates said Contract and/or Small Business Resource Centre (or any part thereof) as aforesaid, then UFSC shall not be liable to the Client other than for a prorated refund of such Client's space price payment determined on the basis of number of Small Business Resource Centre hours remaining. For purposes hereof the phrase "cause or causes not reasonably within the control of UFSC" shall include but not by way of limitation: fire, casualty, flood, epidemic, earthquake or inclement weather; explosion or accident, blockage or embargo; governmental restraints, restraints or orders of civil defense or military authorities; terrorism, act of public enemy, riot, or civil disturbance, strike, lockout, boycott, or other labor disturbance; inability to obtain or condemnation, requisition, or commandeering of necessary supplies or equipment local state or Federal law, ordinances, rule, order decree, or regulation, whether legislative, executive or judicial and whether constitutional or unconstitutional or Acts of God.
